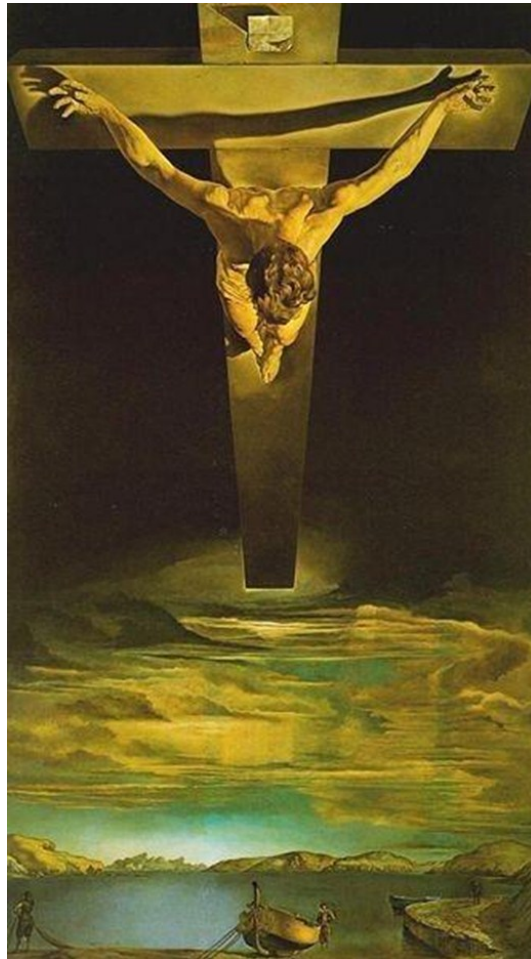

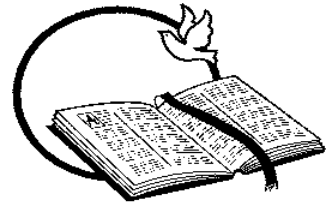
ENTRANCE HYMN
