Amen.





As we remember and cherish your name

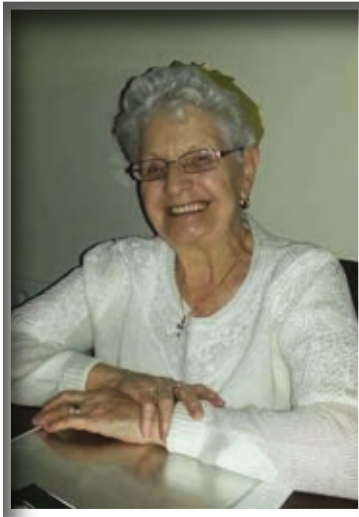
