Praise for them, springing fresh from the Word!

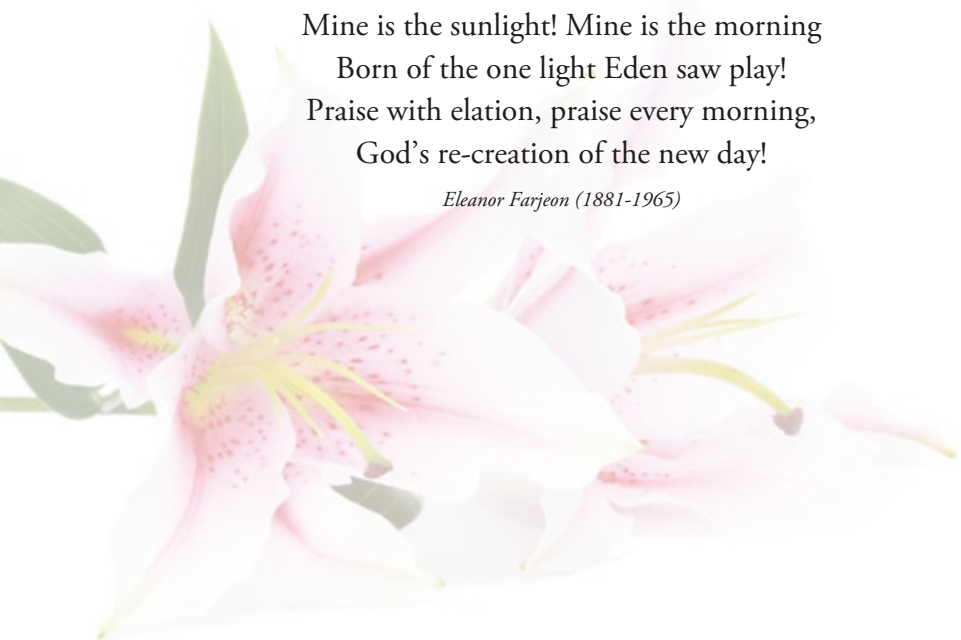
Sweet the rain's new fall sunlit from heaven,
