Amen.

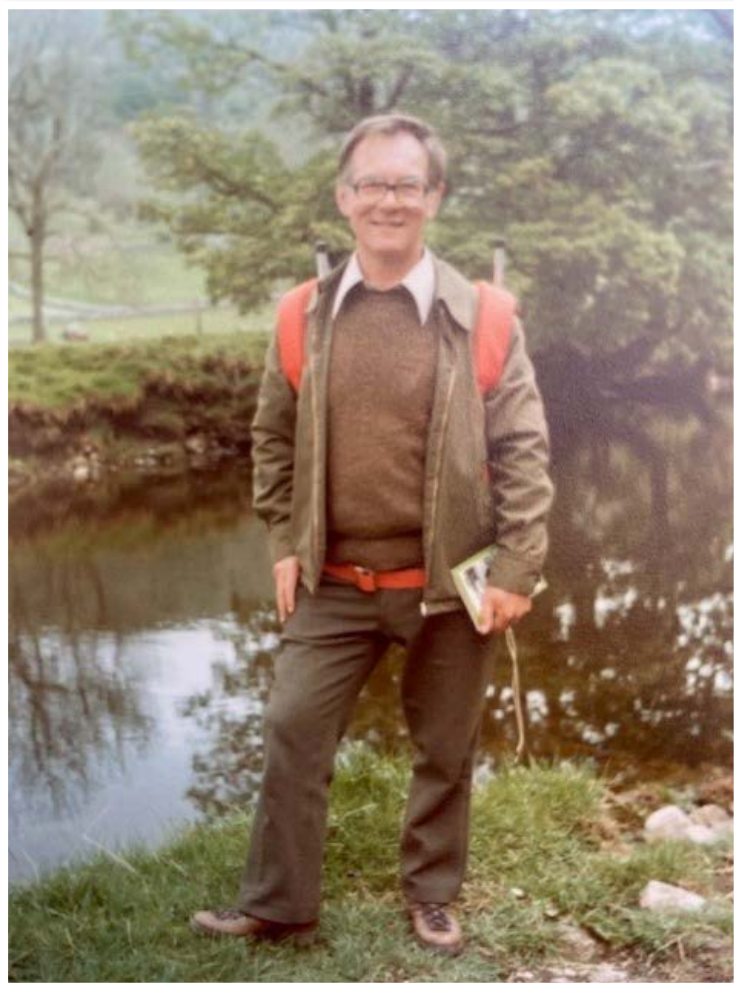

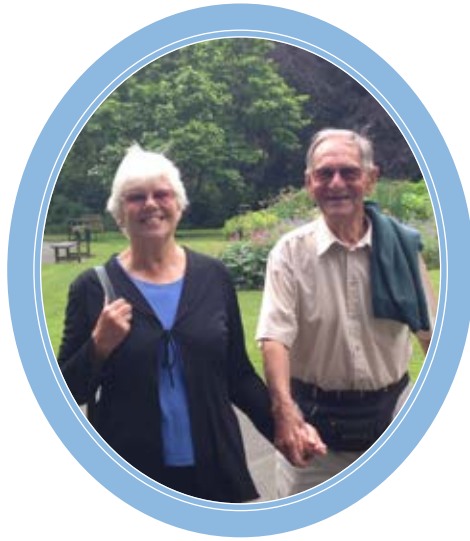
