As you watch the winter fly.

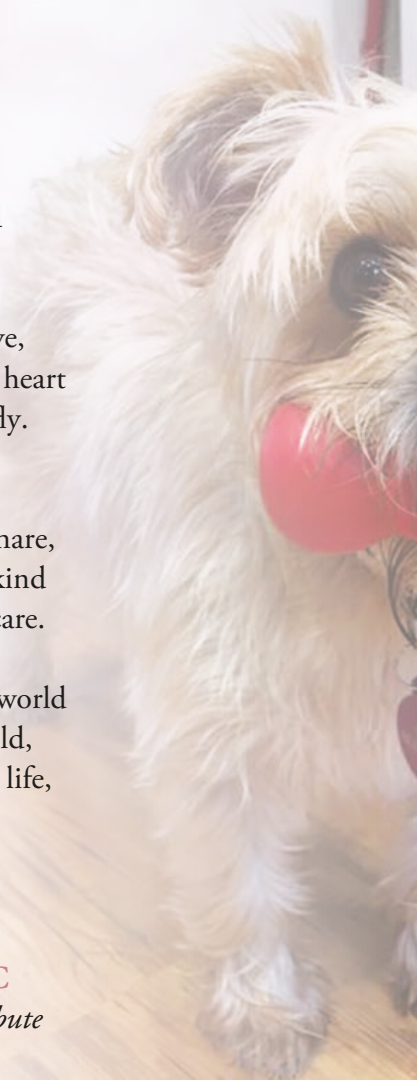
You never will be old


Miss Me But Let Me Go
