Morning has broken like the first morning, Blackbird has spoken like the first bird, Praise for the singing, Praise for the morning, Praise for them springing fresh from the Word!



All things bright and beautiful, All creatures great and small, All things wise and wonderful The Lord God made them all.


Each little flower that opens,


