And the glory forever.

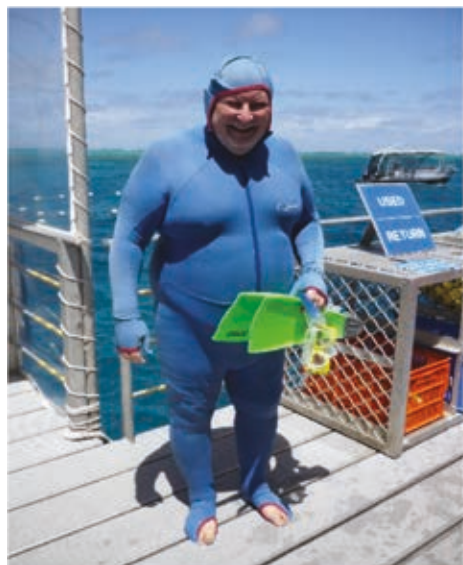
