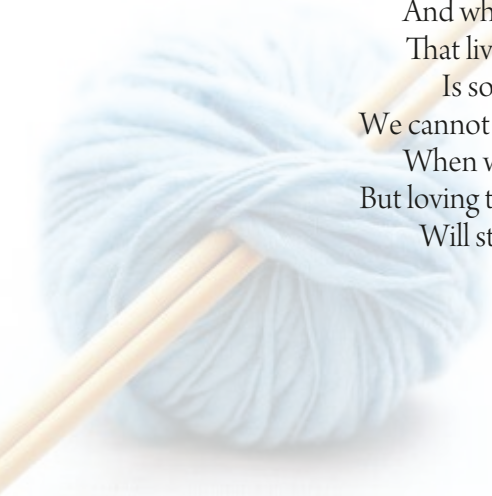




## *Poem*
