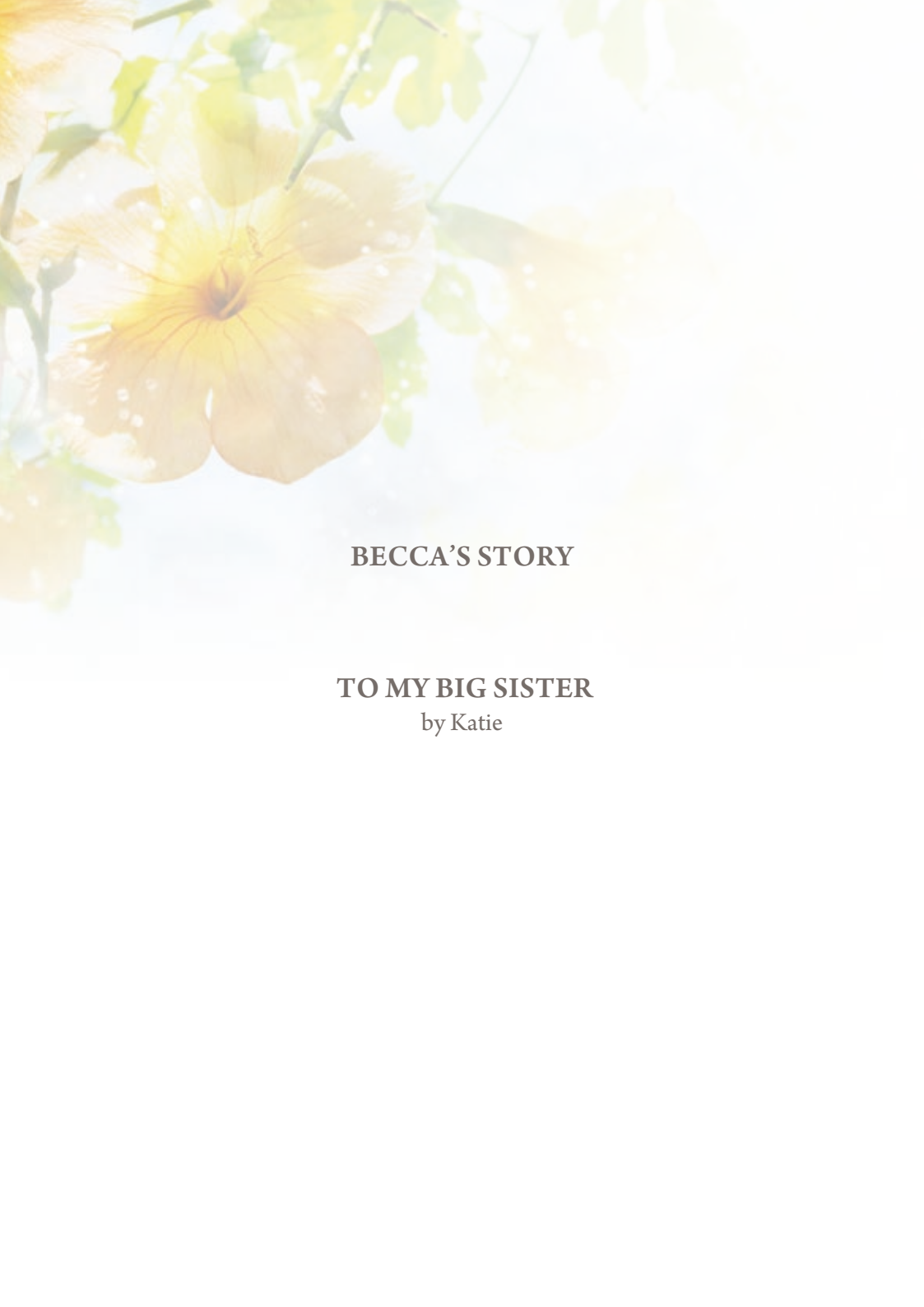

I'll always be with you.

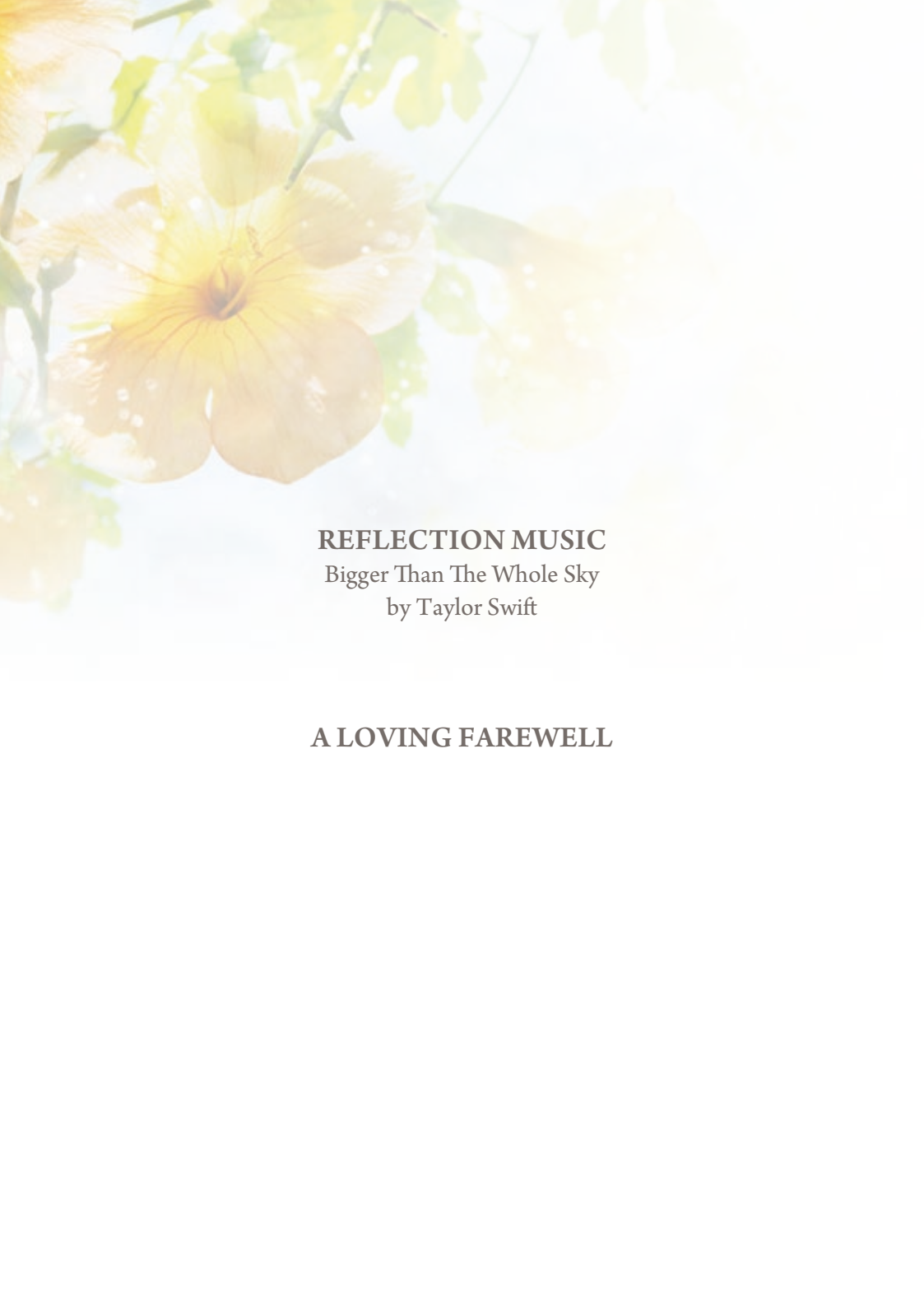
