All safe and blessed we shall meet at last.

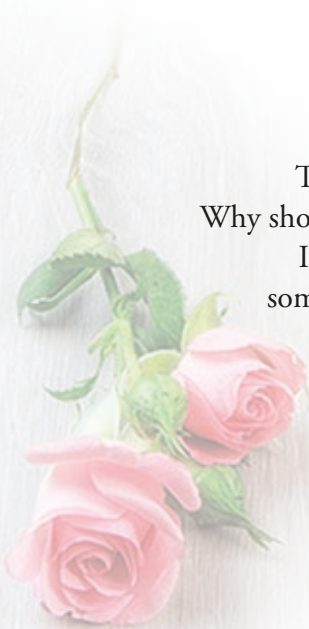
