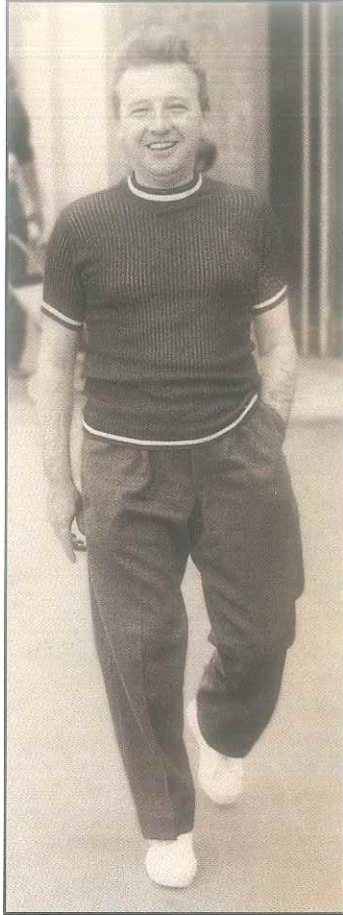
Hymn

All...

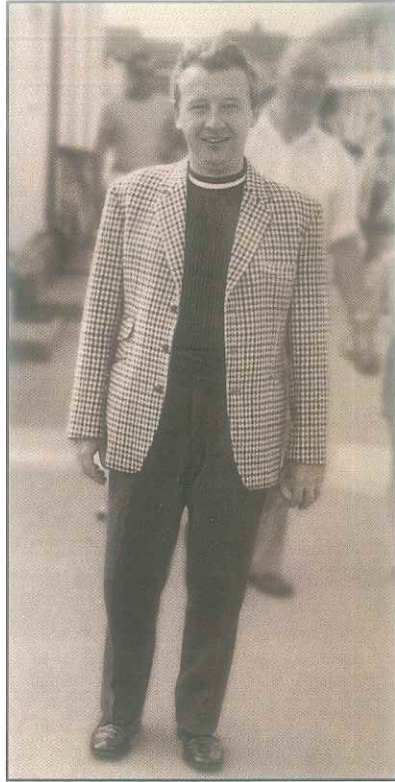
The cold wind in the winter,
