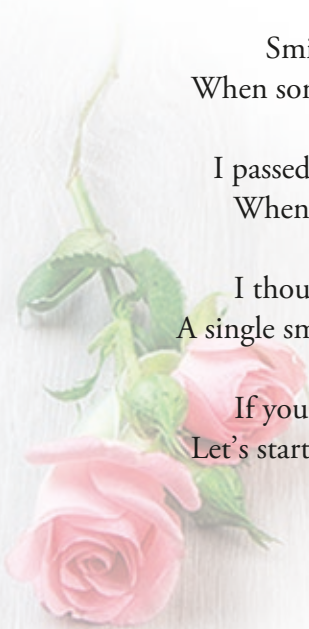


Smiling is infectious, you catch it like the flu.
