Your strength in our hearts, Lord, at the noon of the day.

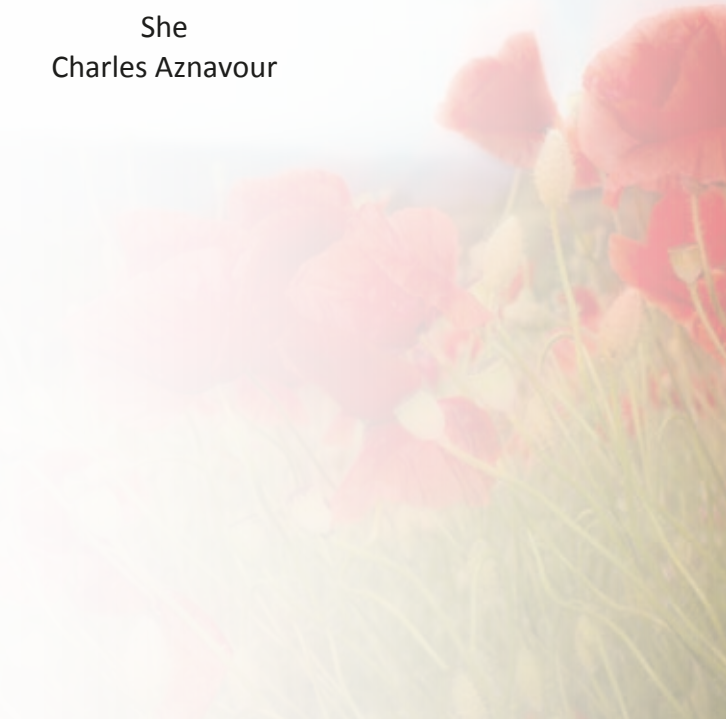
Lord of all kindness, Lord of all grace,
