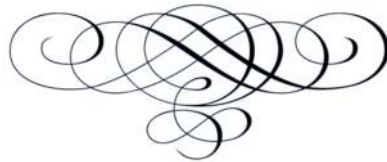

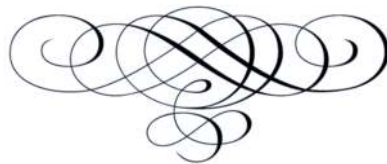
KATHERINE'S MUSIC CHOICE
