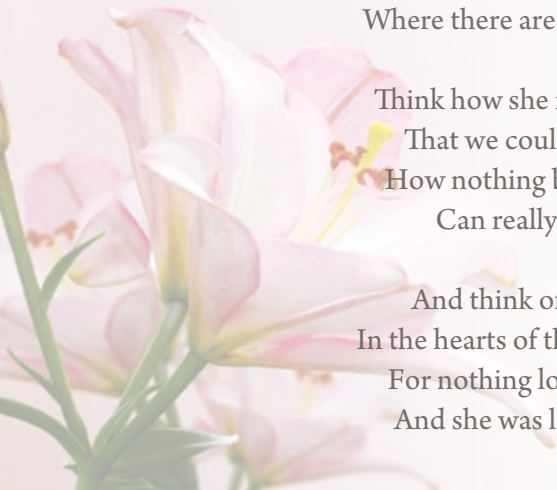
Her Journey's Just Begun

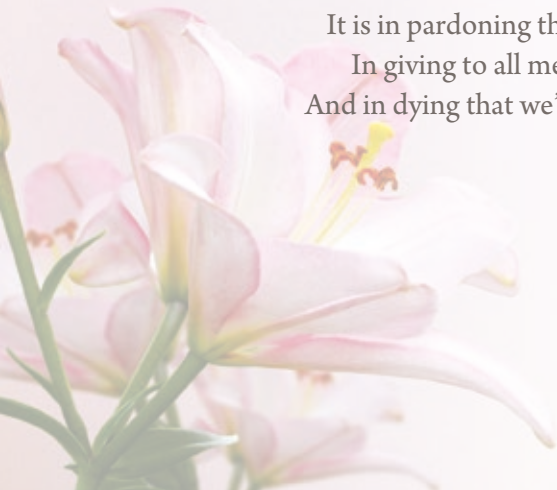
Make me a channel of your peace.
