So I'll cherish the old rugged cross...



And I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.



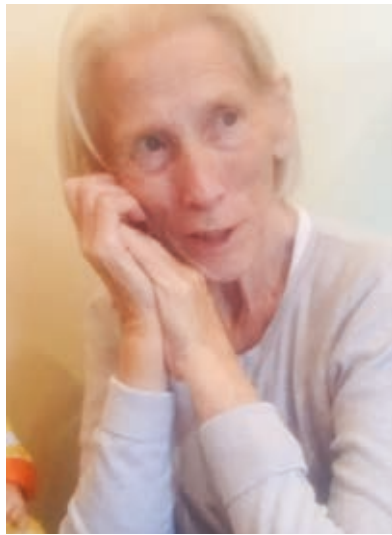
