The quiet waters by.


My soul He doth restore again,

The Sailing Ship

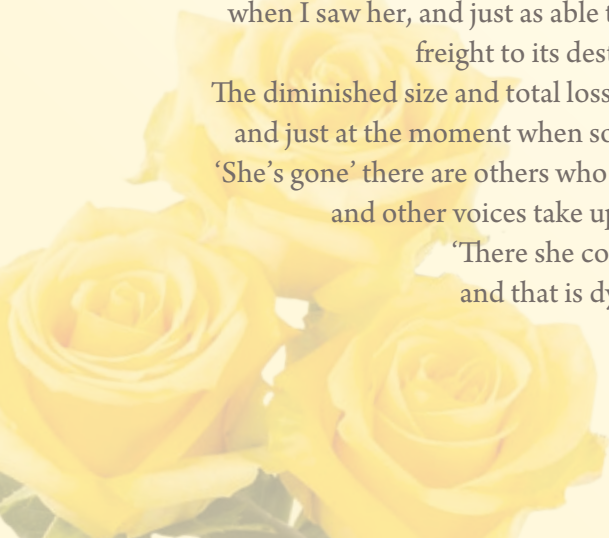
read by her great-nephew, Blair
