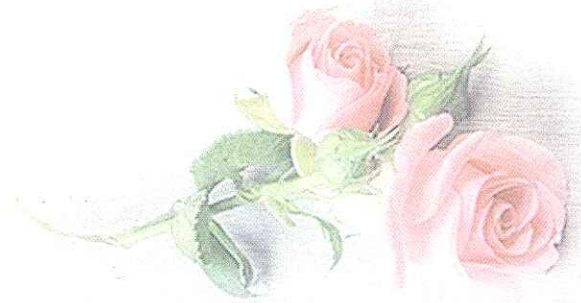

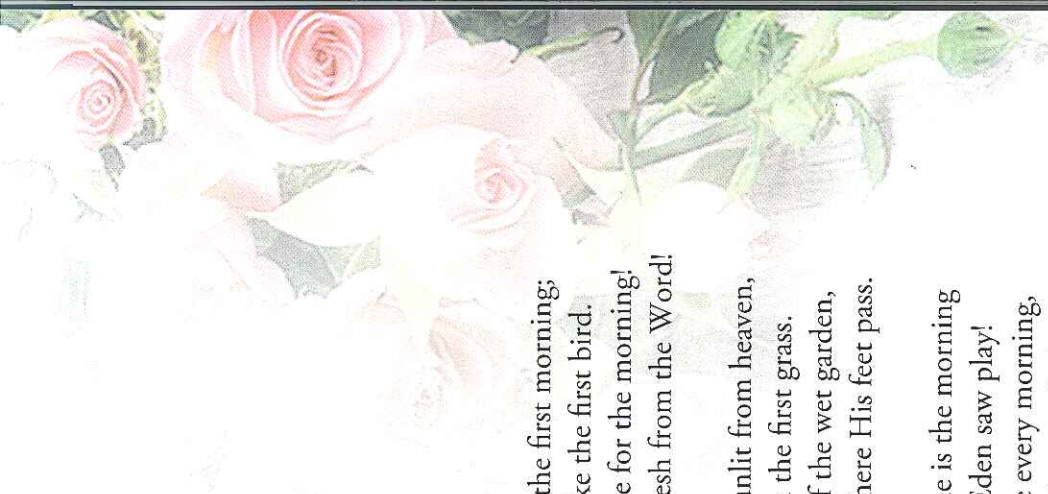
HYMN

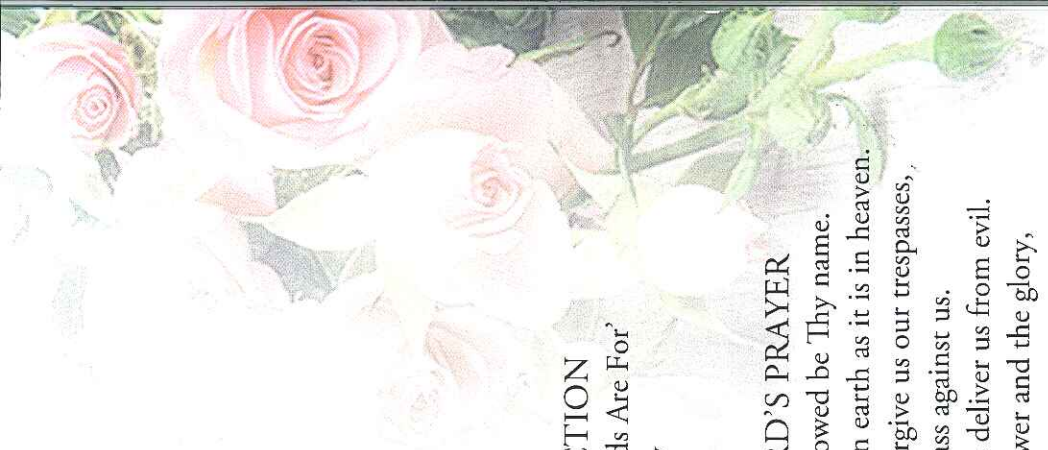
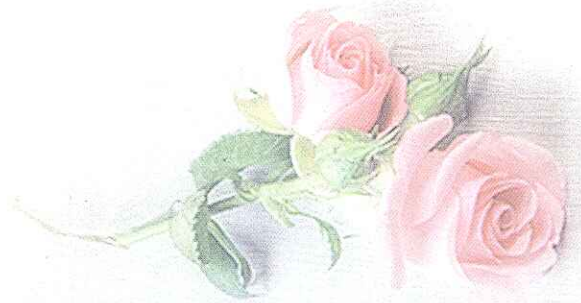

Let memories surround you, a word someone may say

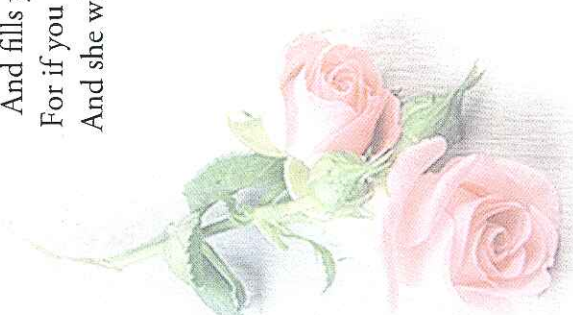
Will suddenly recapture a time, an hour, a day,
