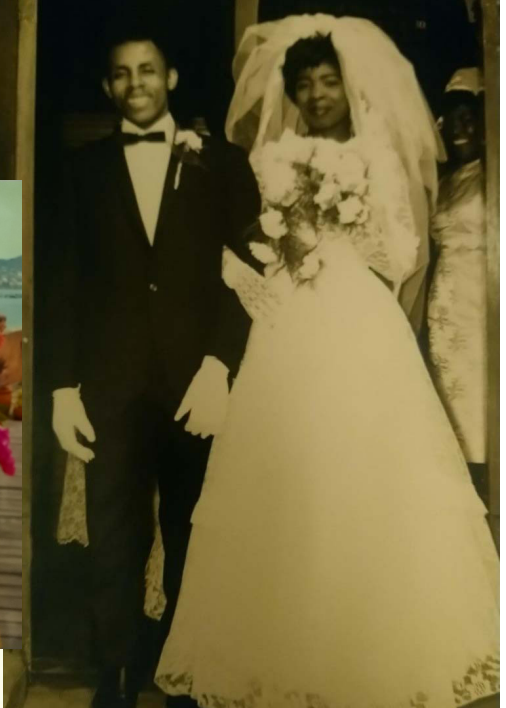
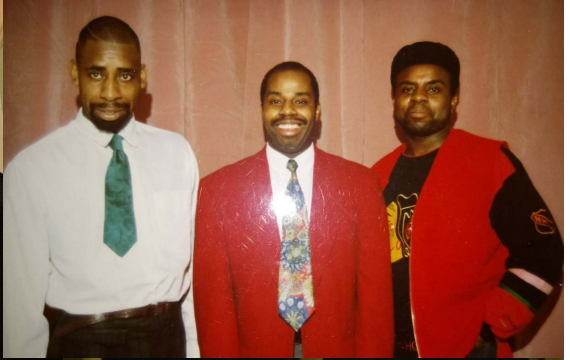
*I'll fly away, Oh Glory

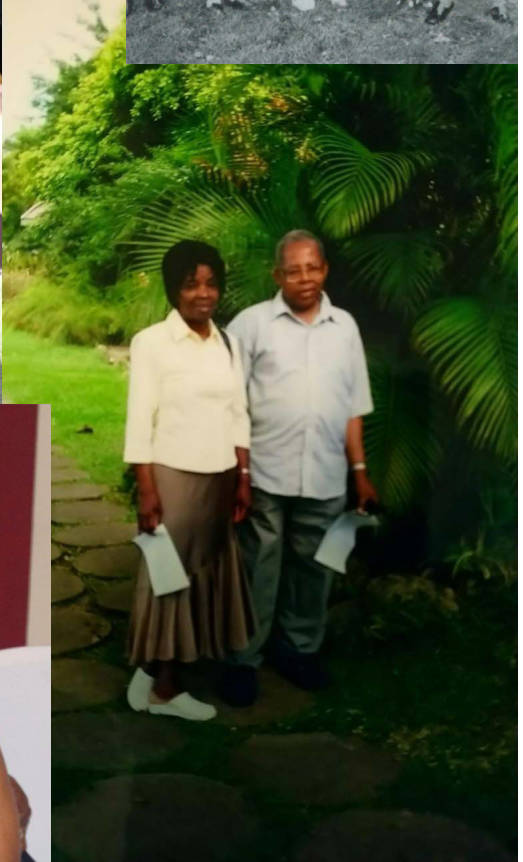












# *Blessed Jesus Hold My Hand*
