Or you can cherish his memory and let it live on.

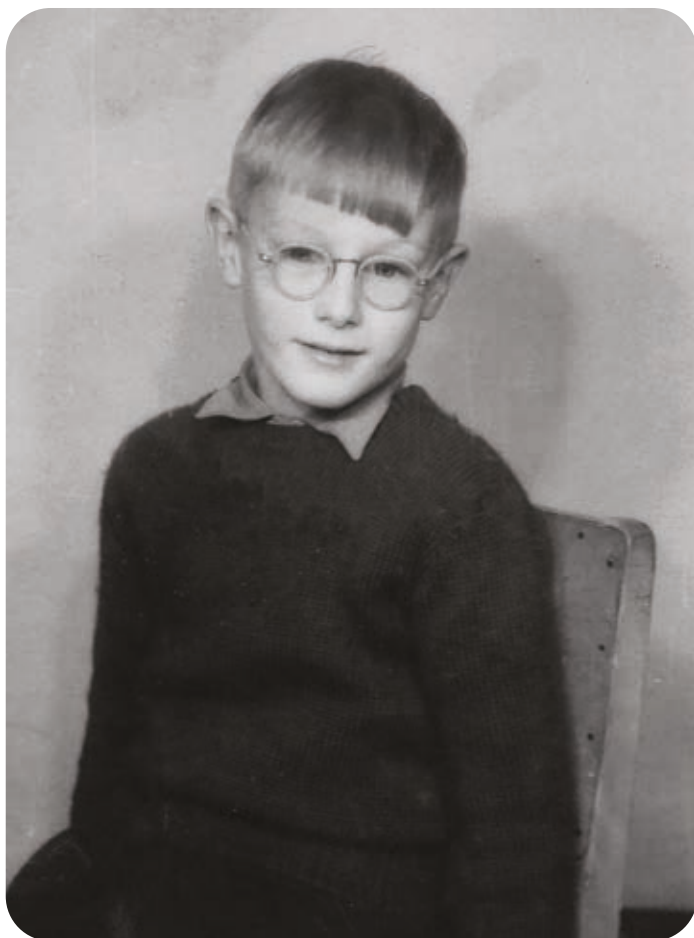
You can cry and close your mind, be empty and turn your back
