*All things bright...*

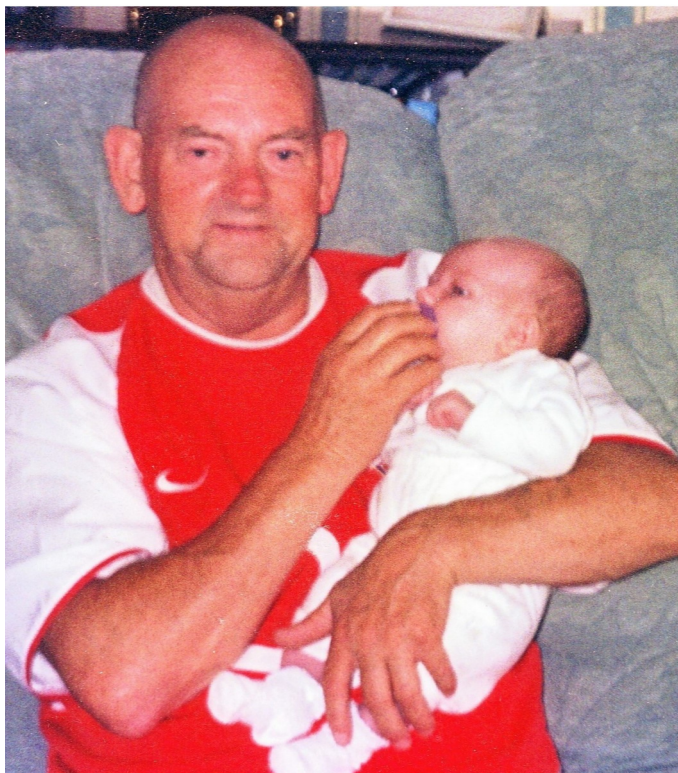
