I was happy, that's enough!

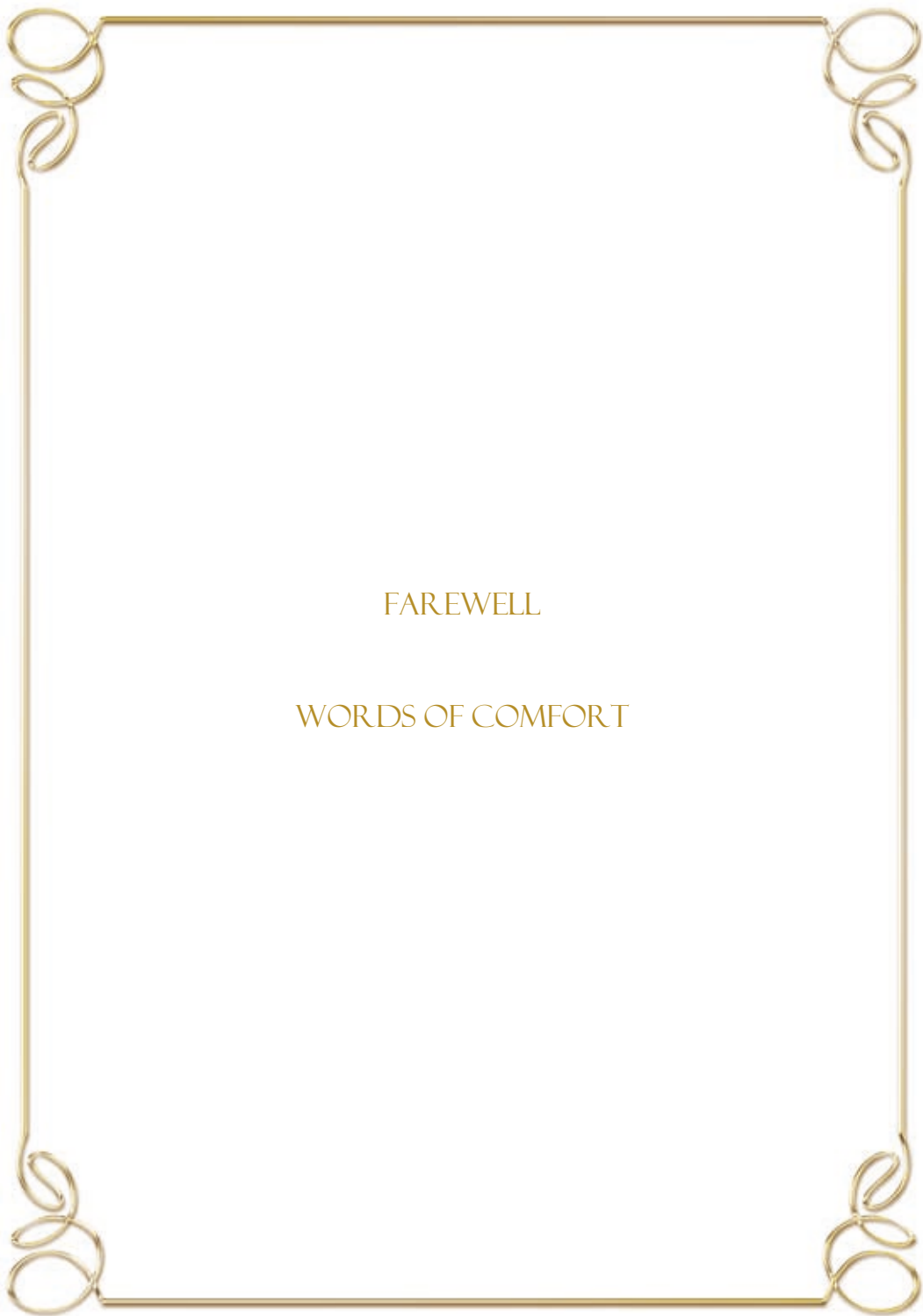
