Your peace in our hearts, Lord, at the end of the day.

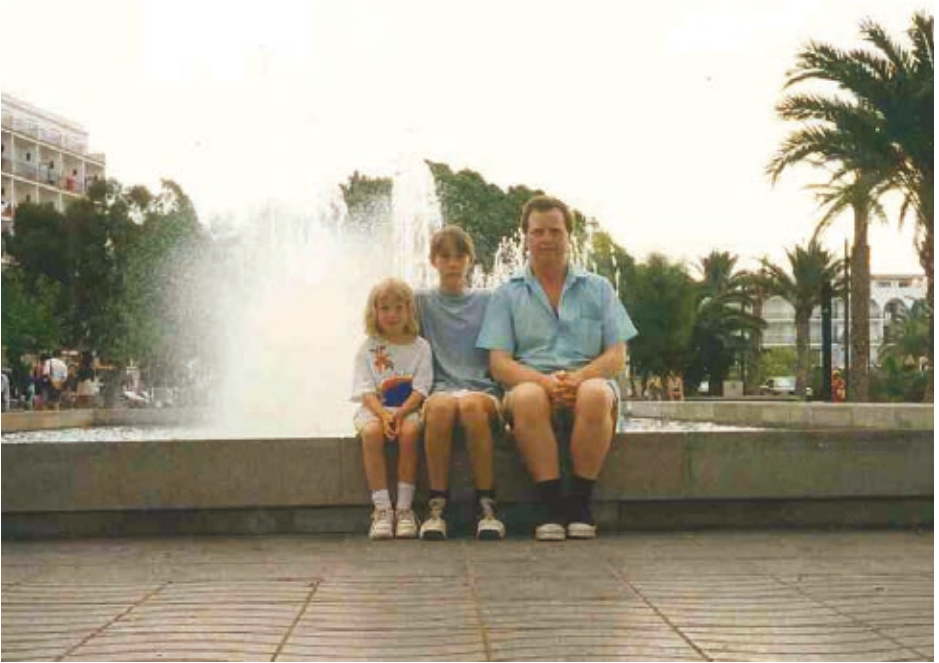
