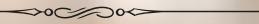

Amen.

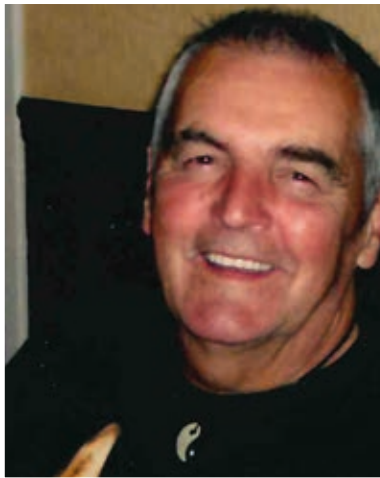
