his faithfulness continues through all generations.

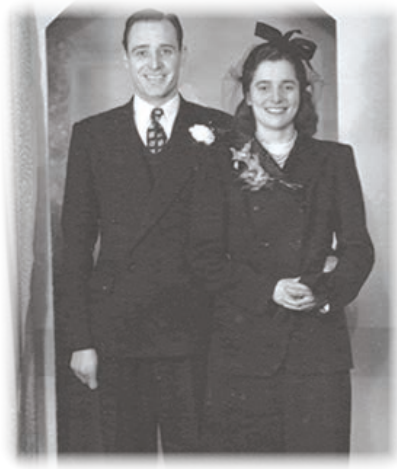
