or you can smile because she has lived.

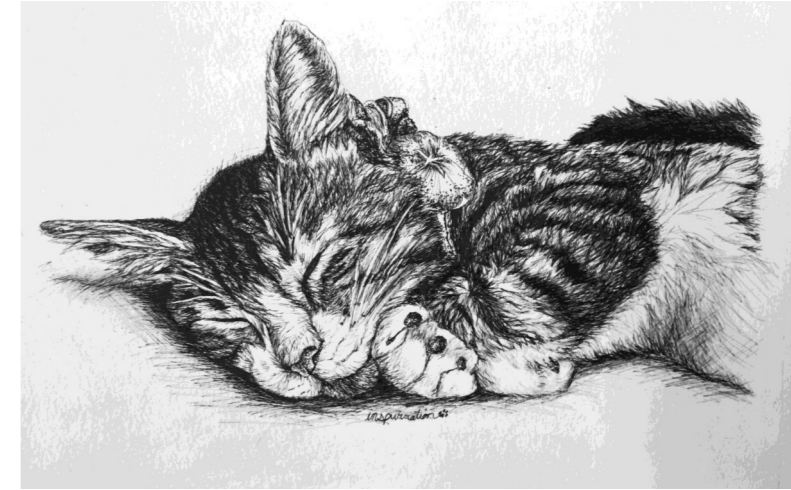
You can close your eyes and pray that she'll come back
