Liturgy of the Word

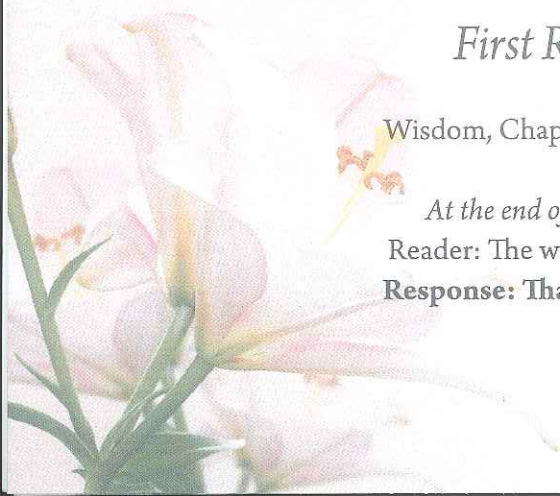
First Reading

At the end of the Gospel:

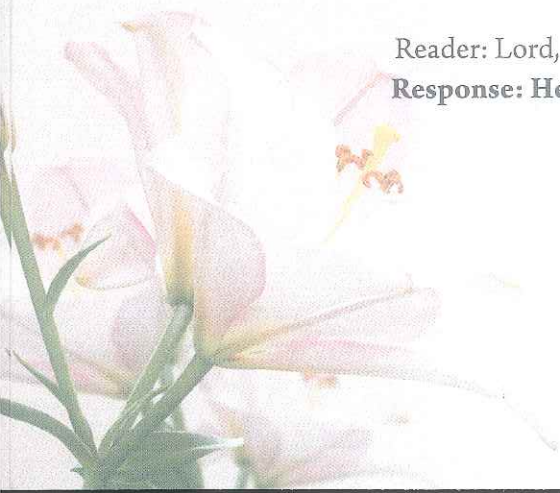
Priest: The Gospel of the Lord.

Recessional Hymn

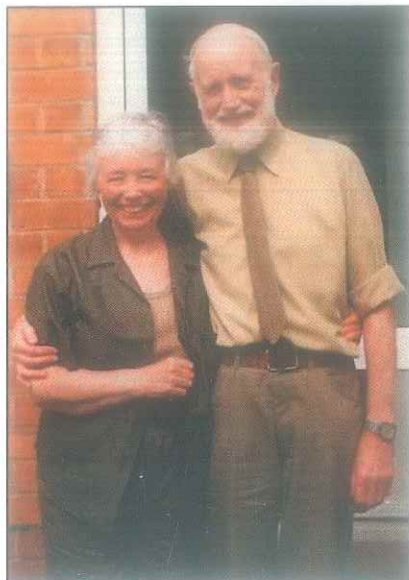
Lord of all hopefulness, Lord of all joy,
