

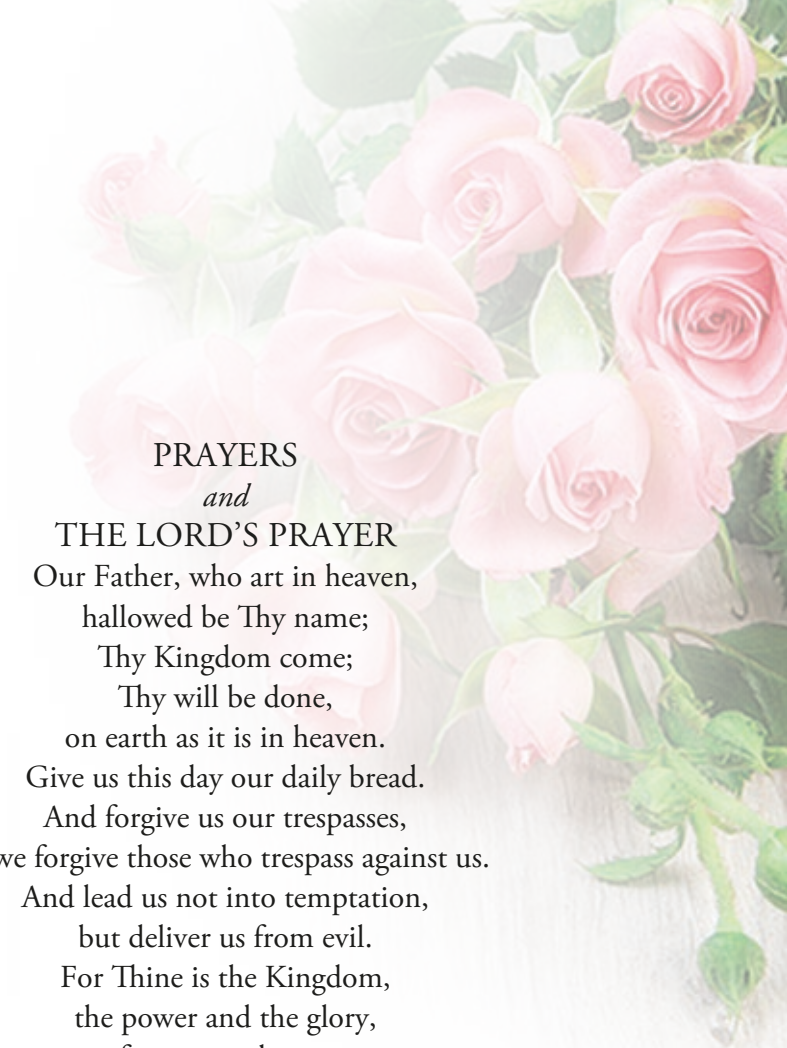

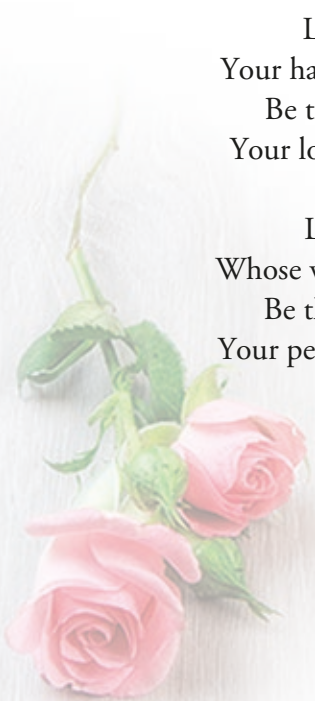
Lord of all hopefulness, Lord of all joy,
