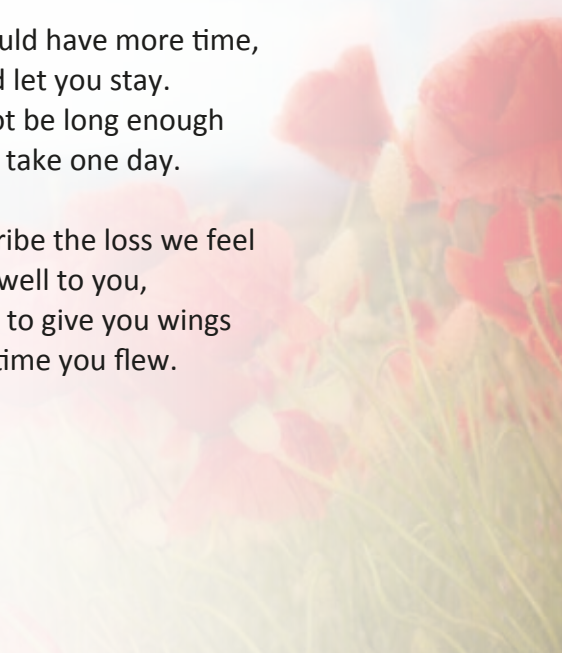
POEM
