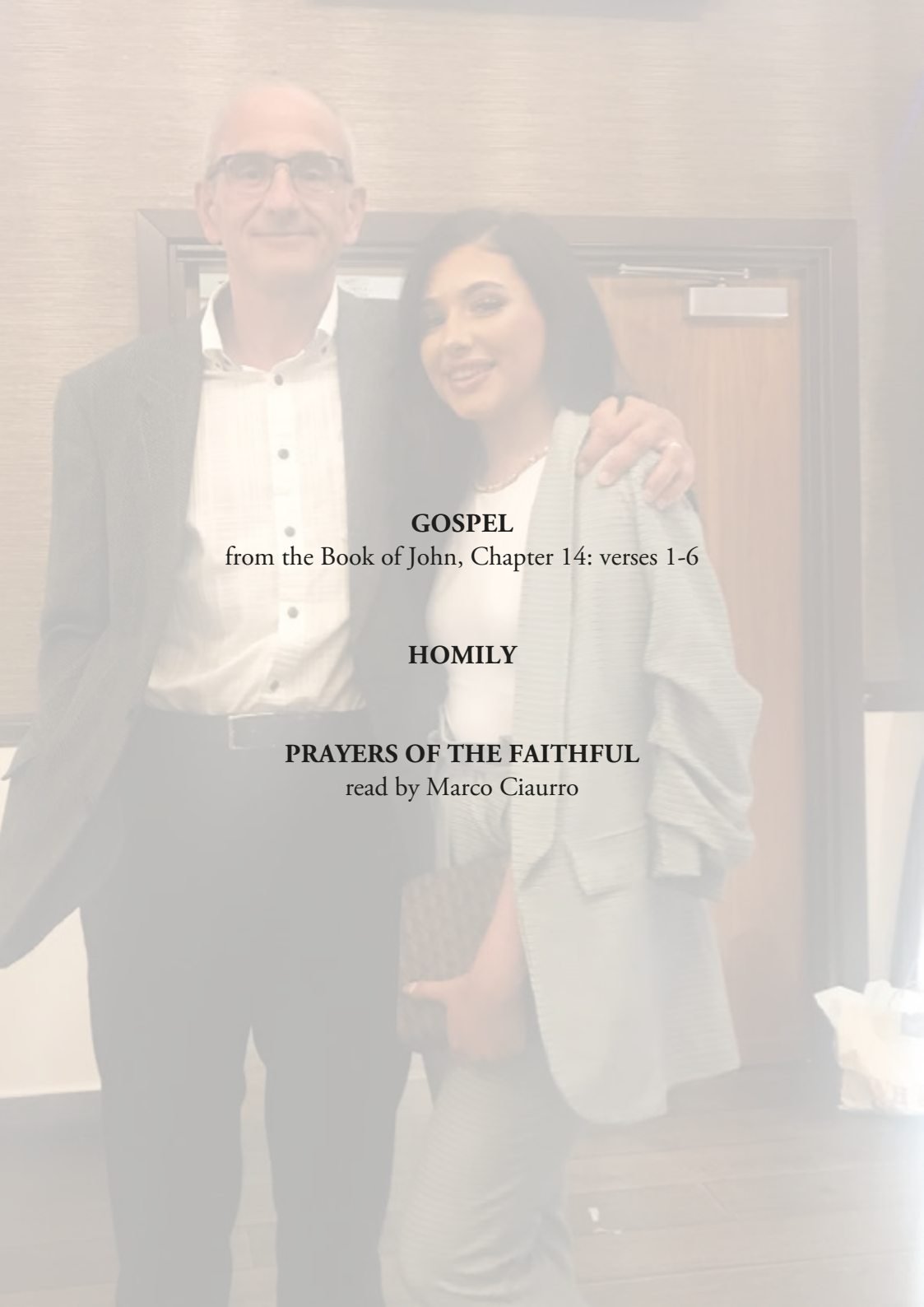
As the deer pants for the water,
