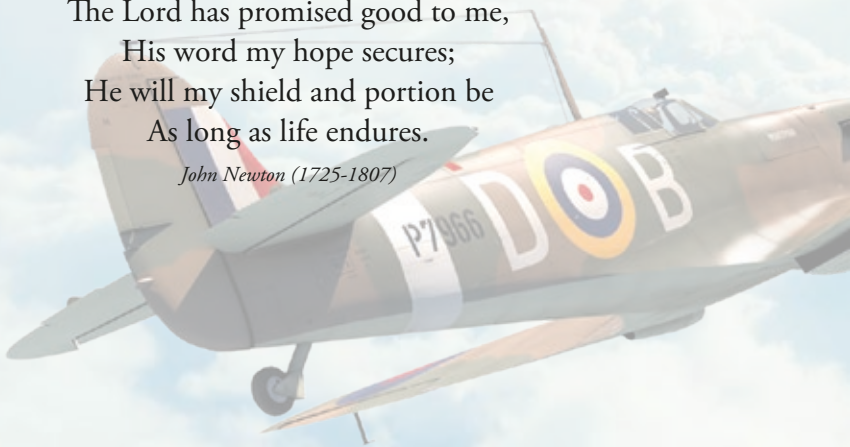
Amazing grace, how sweet the sound
