Amen.

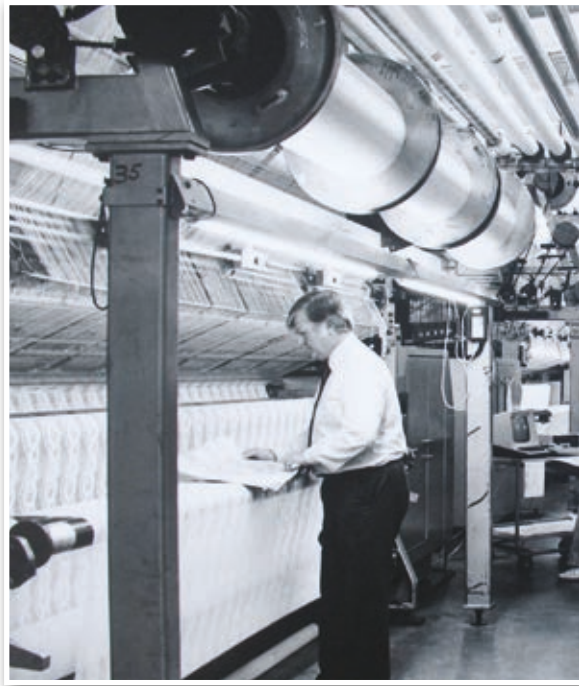


HYMN
