Each of this family carrying him in their physical and integrity make up.

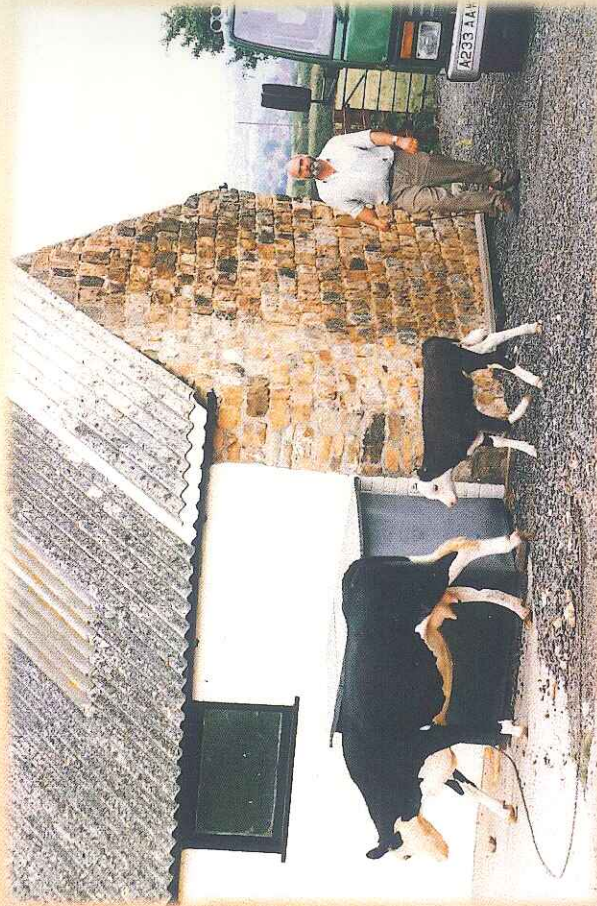
Friends carry him in our hearts and integrity.

the power and the glory,

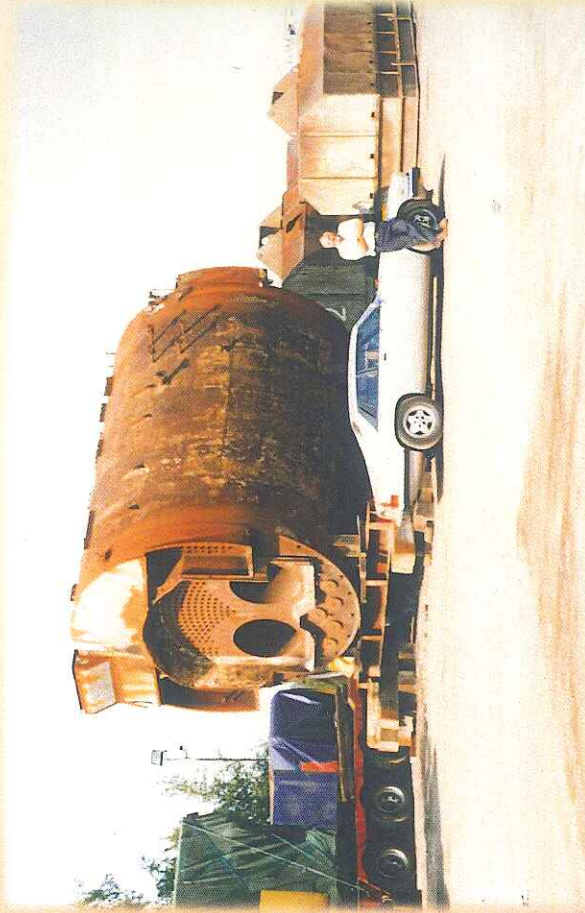
