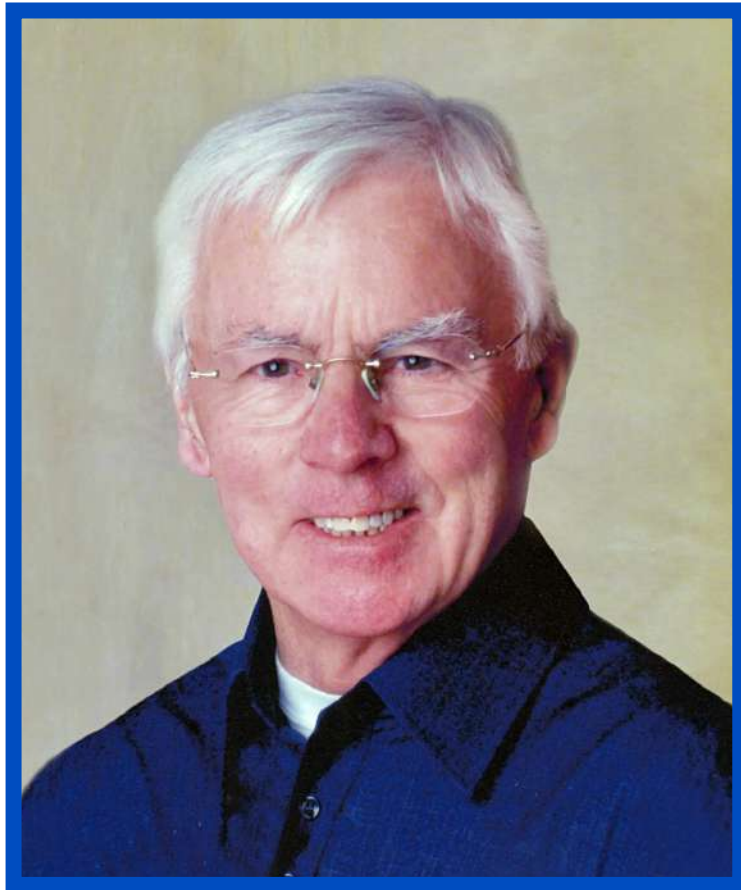

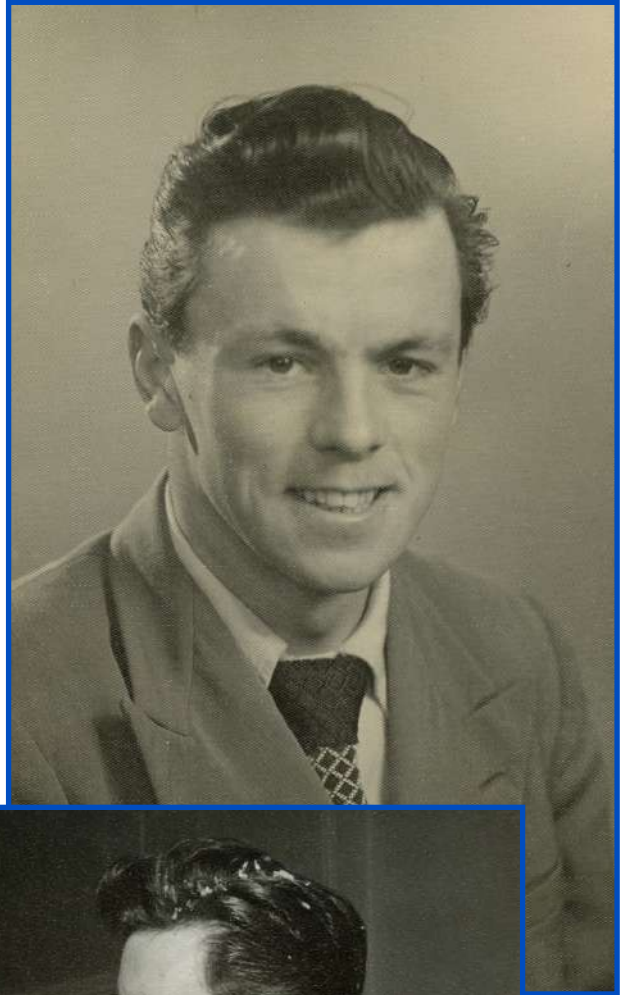

Then sings my soul...

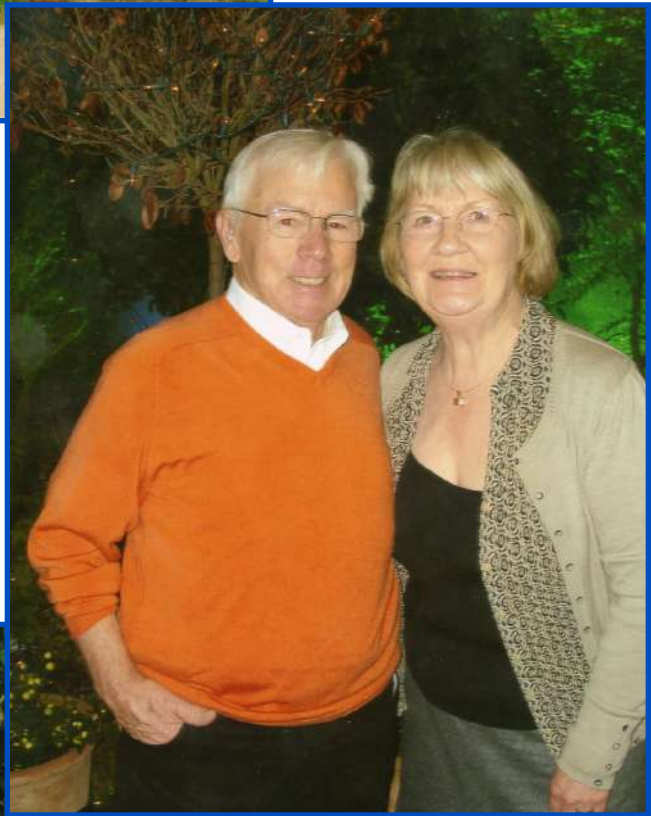
When Christ shall come with shout of acclamation

And there proclaim; My God how great thou art!

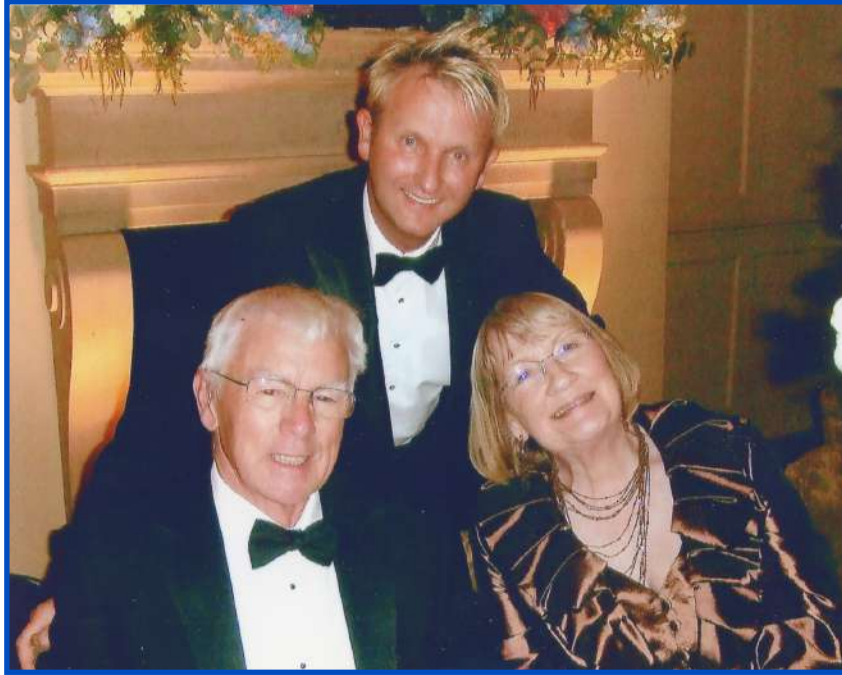
