FIRST READING

An extract from the prophet Isaiah, Chapter 30: verses 18-26

In this passage, Isaiah speaks about God's gracious love reaching out to Monica and to each one of us. Isaiah also uses imagery from nature to try to describe the blessings that our loving God wishes to give us.

The Lord is waiting to be gracious to you, to rise and have mercy on you, blessed are all who hope in him. Yes, you will weep no more. The Lord will be gracious to you when your cry for help rings out; as soon as he hears it, he will answer you. When the Lord has given you the bread of suffering and the water of distress, he who is your teacher will hide no longer, and you will see your teacher with your own eyes.

Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear these words behind you, 'This is the way, follow it.'

He will send rain for the seed you sow, and the bread that the ground provides will be rich and nourishing.

That day, your cattle will graze in wide pastures.

Oxen and donkeys that till the ground will eat a salted fodder.

On every lofty mountain, on every high hill,

there will be rivers and streams of water.

Then moonlight will be bright as sunlight and sunlight itself be seven times brighter - like the light of seven days in one.

On that day, the Lord will dress his people's wounds and heal the bruises of the blows they have received.

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.


Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
