Than when we'd first begun.

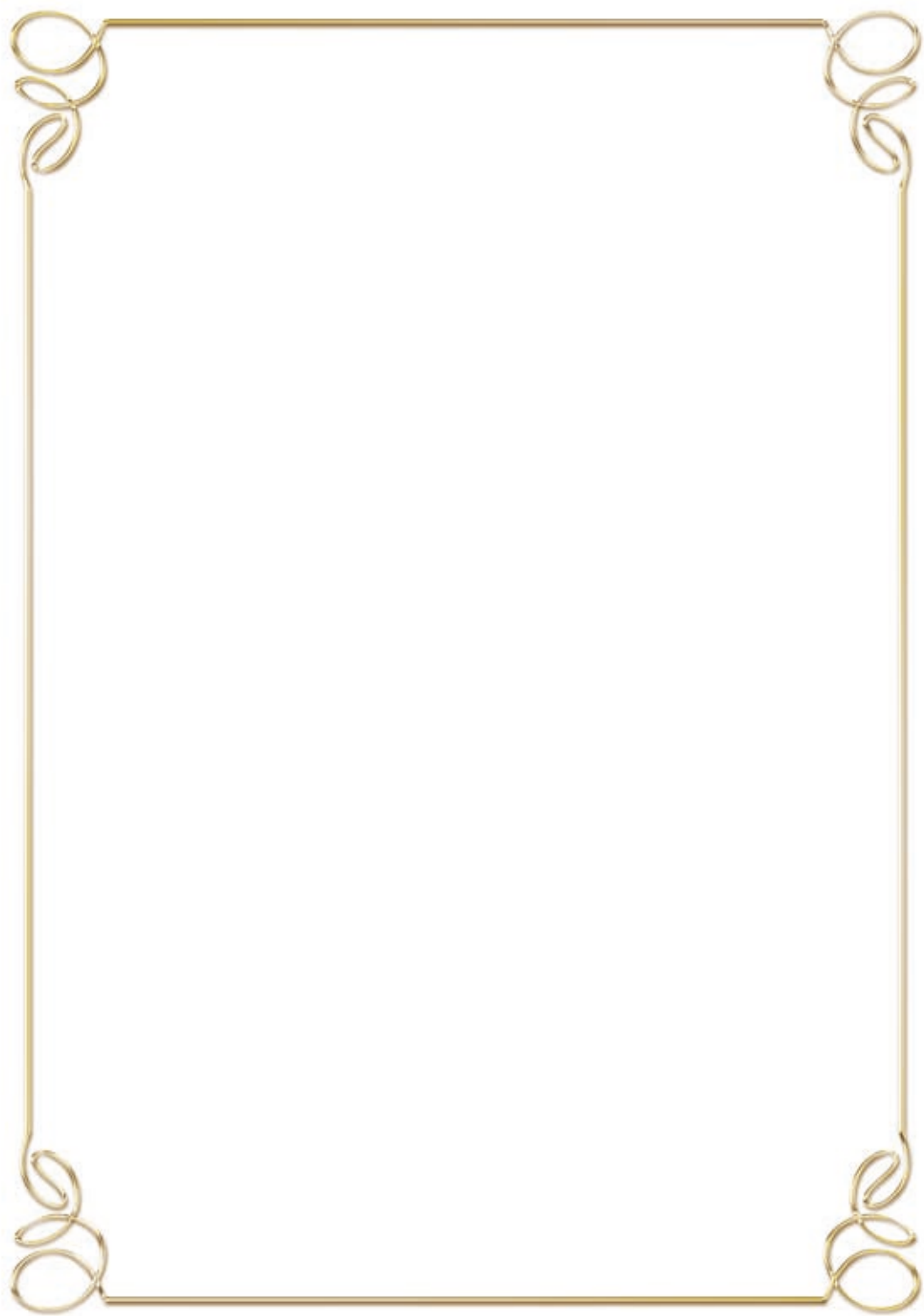
