When they told me what was happening and that my lovely mum might not make it, I freaked out, and for that, I am sorry, Mum.

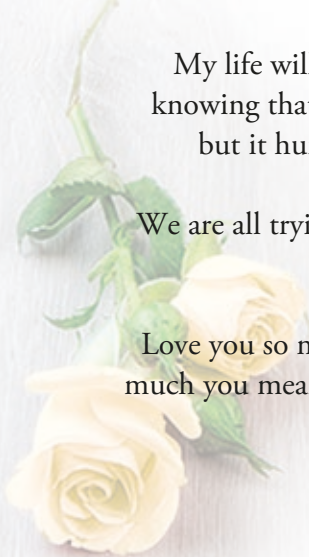
I tried to be strong for you, even though my heart was breaking.



You quietly left us all.


