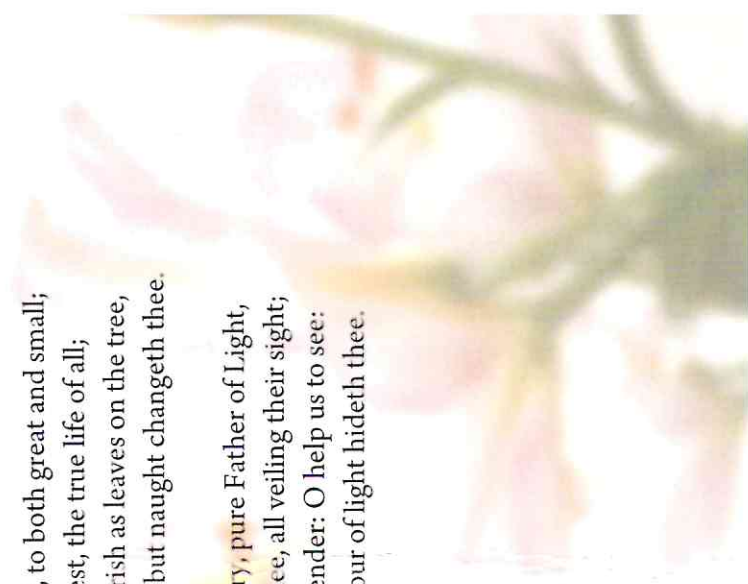
## *Hymn*

And lead us not into temptation;

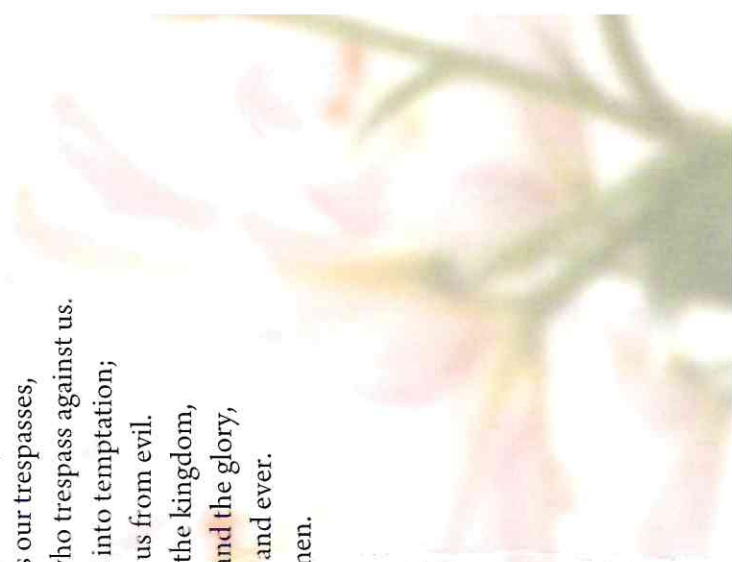
but deliver us from evil.
