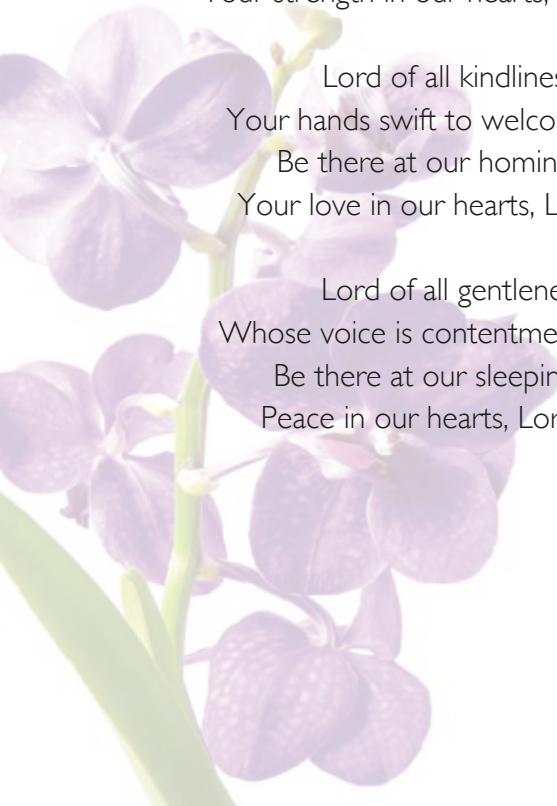
HYMN

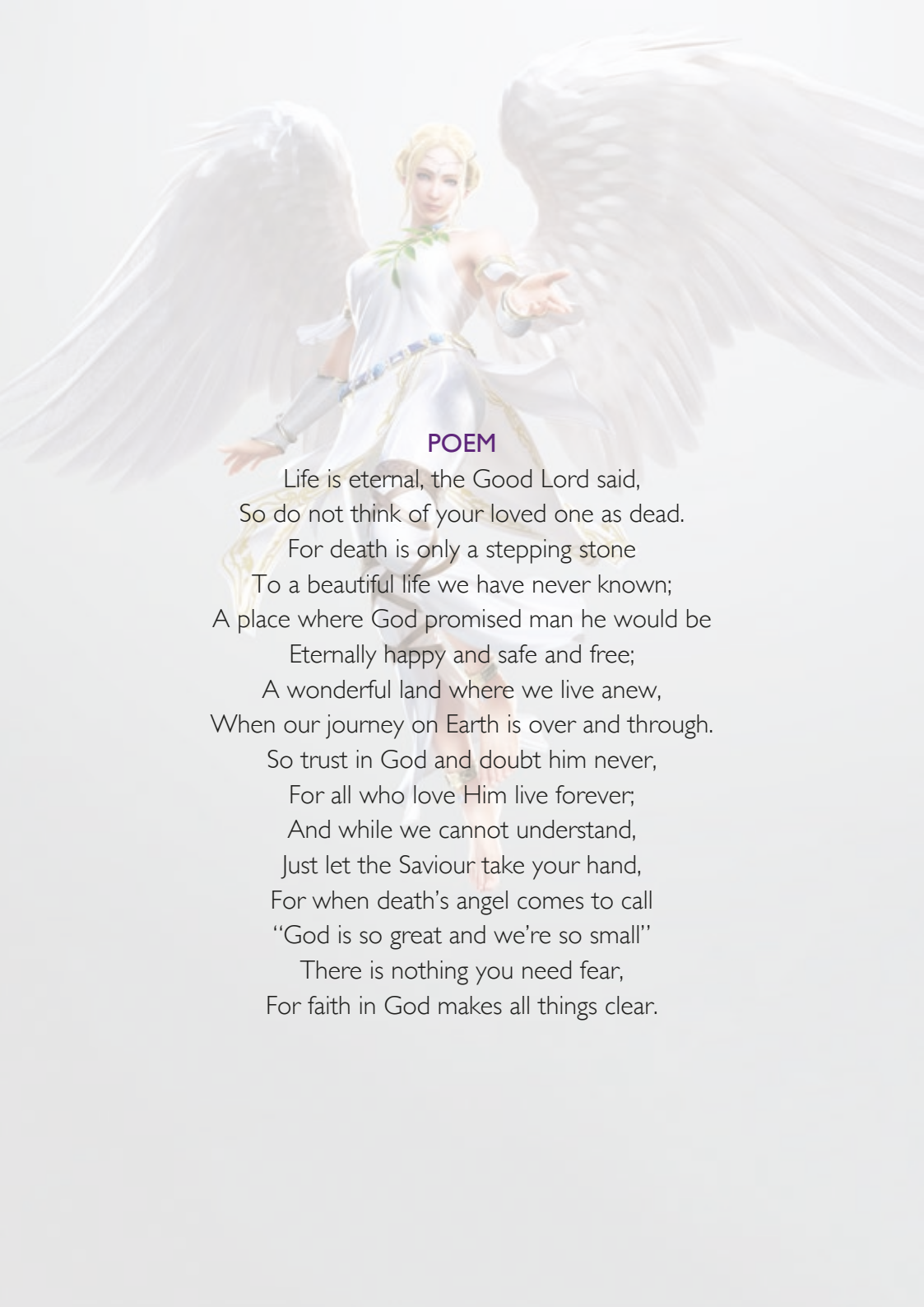
HYMN
