



## Emily's Inspirational Charity (est. 2013)

Emily (Clayton) was a primary school teacher in Nottingham for 11 years.

In September 2012 she was diagnosed with cholangiocarcinoma
(bile duct cancer) and died on 27th November 2012 aged 33 years.

Emily was inspirational and passionate about ensuring every child she taught had all the opportunities they needed and were not disadvantaged

(especially financially) in any way.

This charity has been set up by her family, friends and colleagues in order to fund opportunities for such children to take part in events and activities that will make a difference to their future lives and inspire them to success, fulfilment, achievement and happiness.

Emily was the daughter of a good friend and work colleague of Wayne's. Wayne knew her from childhood and he and Sue have always supported the charity.

## **Breathe Easy Nottingham**

Breathe Easy Nottingham was one of Wayne's favoured charities. It is one of a network of support groups for people living with lung disease, operating under the umbrella of the British Lung Foundation (BLF), which is the national charity looking at all aspects of lung health. Breathe Easy Nottingham has been going for 15 years, putting on a monthly programme of events, talks, outings etc., all from the welcoming and social atmosphere of its base at Edwalton Golf Club. It is free for all, run entirely by volunteers, with no formal funding except that raised by its members. Wayne played a key role in its organisation, adding a large dose of common sense and incite to committee meetings. He was the driving force behind setting up our weekly exercise classes, plugging a much needed gap in NHS provision. He also acted as the patient voice interfacing with Rushcliffe's Clinical Commissioning Group, addressing all aspects of diagnosis and treatment which we, as patients, experience. He will be sorely missed.
