“I feel your brightness near me.”

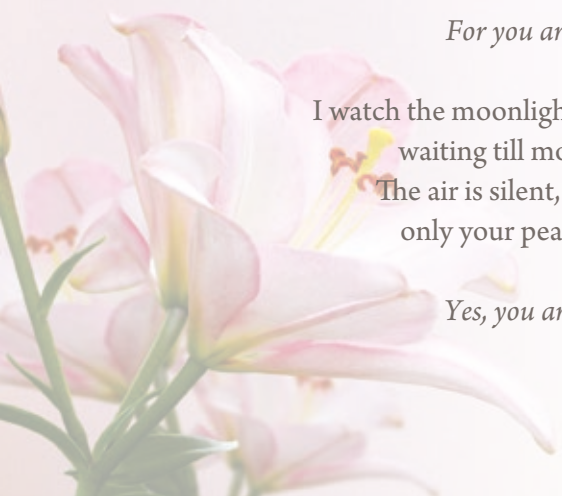
For you are always...

Final Hymn

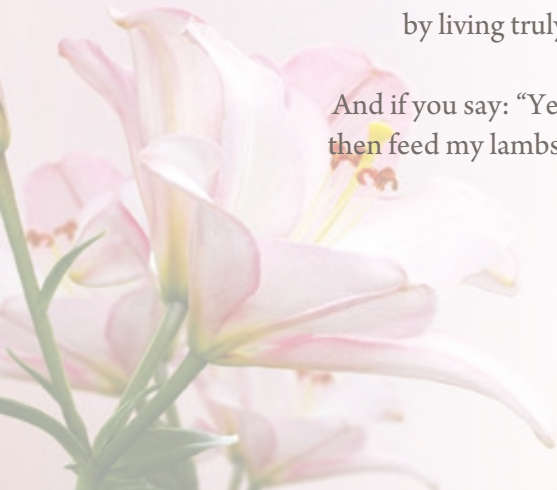
*I will be with you wherever you go.
