For if you keep those moments you will never be apart

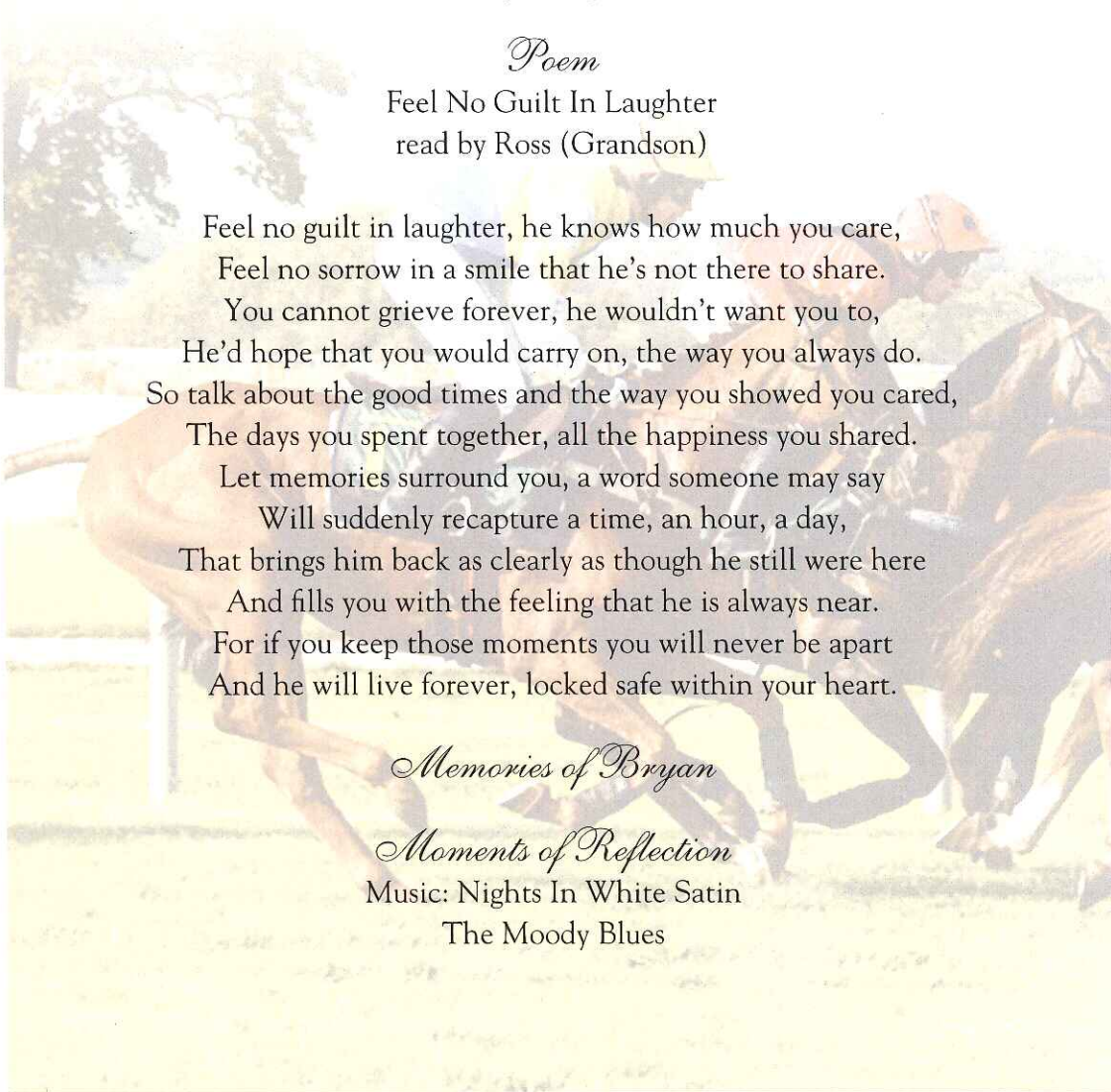
And he will live forever, locked safe within your heart.
