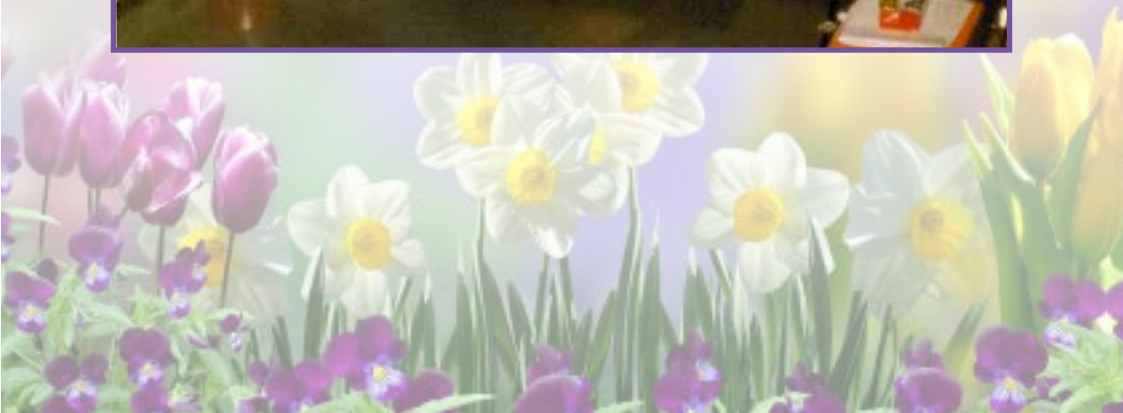

The Gentle Gardener by Edgar Albert Guest

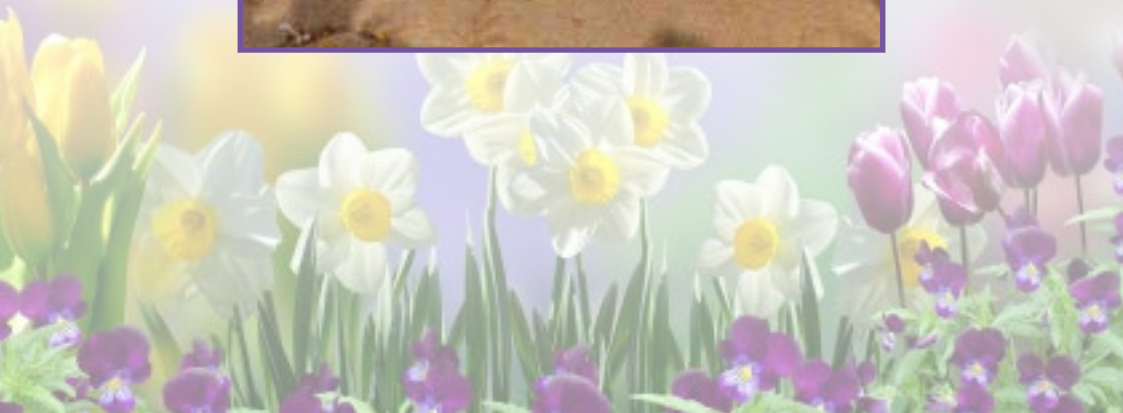
I'd like to leave but daffodills
